Amendments to Supplementary Sailing Instructions 2021 for racing on 17 July 2021 Albert Park Yacht Club – Albert Sailing Club

The Supplementary Sailing Instructions 2021 are amended as follows <u>only</u> in relation to sailing conducted on 17 July 2021:

1	Organising Authority	The Organising Authority is the Albert Sailing Club
SSI 5	Start Time	For racing on 17 July 2021, a briefing session will be held at 12.45 p.m. The first warning signal will issue at 1.27 p.m. with the first race start at 1.30 p.m.
SSI 7 & 8	Courses, Marks & Divisions	See below
SSI 9	Scoring	Multiple races will be conducted of which 2 races are required to constitute a series. No drops will be allowed.
SSI 17	The Finish	As set out in the Supplementary Sailing Instructions amended as follows: The finish line will be: between a mast or staff displaying a blue flag on the race committee finishing vessel and the finishing mark, which will fly a green flag if a further race will be conducted in the relevant session, or a red flag if there is no further racing in the session. between the club tower and the finishing mark, which will fly a green flag if a further race will be conducted in the relevant session, or a red flag if there is no further racing in the session.

Courses, Marks and Divisions


Courses will consist of short course races in Albert Park Lake around a series of marks located in the Northern and Southern basins of the lake including the entrance to the 'Narrows'. No racing will take place in the St Kilda Road basin. At the discretion of the race officer, each course may include Inner (I) and Outer (O) Marks for all or any marks of the course.

The specific courses to be sailed and the location of the marks will be determined by the Race Officer and will depend on the conditions on the day. See Appendix A for further details.

Divisional flags will be numeral pennants. The allocation of classes to Divisions will be posted on the <u>regatta website</u> no later than 5 p.m. on Friday 16 July and will be displayed on the official Race Notice Board.

The course(s) for the session, whether the Division is sailing the Outer or Inner marks and whether there will be a finish line or a common start/finish boat will be posted on the Course Board in the briefing area at least 30 minutes before the first warning signal for each session. The island may have a required side; this will be defined on the course board at briefing prior to a session.




