

# 2022 - 2023 Annual Membership Fees

Membership Category	Annual Fee*
<b>Family</b> – <i>Adult, Spouse or Partner, eligible Juniors and/or Students of the same family unit to a maximum of six persons.</i>	\$480
<b>Senior</b> – <i>Aged 18 years and over as at 1<sup>st</sup> April</i>	\$335
<b>Junior</b> – <i>Aged under 18 years as at 1<sup>st</sup> April</i>	\$160
<b>Student/Apprentice</b> – <i>Full time students aged 18 years and less than 25 years as at 1<sup>st</sup> April</i>	\$205
<b>Pensioner</b> – <i>Full-time pensioner, or holder of disability card as at the date of application or renewal</i>	\$205
<b>Social</b> – <i>Non-sailing member, desiring to maintain contact with club (e.g. parents of Junior members, persons retiring from sailing category membership)</i>	\$100
<b>Corporate</b>	\$480

\*There is no joining fee for new members in 2022/23

- Annual Membership and Racking Fees are payable each year at 1 October
- Membership & Racking Fee from 1 April to 30 June is 50% of the corresponding annual fees
- Membership & Racking Fee from 1 July to 30 September 2023 is full annual fee but with membership through to 30 September 2024

## Annual Boatyard Racking Fee

**Racking is allocated on application, subject to availability.**

Rack Type	Fee
Top Rack	\$185
Middle Rack	\$215
Bottom Rack	\$270
Minnow/Opti/Open Bic Rack	\$140

*Club racking is not a cheap storage for unused boats. Boats left on rack and not sailed are liable to removal from their racks, as detailed in the Club by-laws*

**Boats are stored on Club premises entirely at boat owners' risk. The Club does not carry insurance for member's boats.**
