- There is no joining fee. Annual membership and Storage Fees are payable each year at 1 October
- New members who join from 1 April to 30 June pay 50% of the corresponding annual membership and racking fees.
- New members who join from 1 July 2026 to 30 September 2026 pay the full annual fee and receive membership through to 30 September 2027.
- The Boatshed charges \$295.00 for club members referred to Learn to Sail. New members who wish to Learn to Sail will pay half (\$147.50) and Albert Sailing Club will pay the remaining half (\$147.50).

Kayak – small kayaks that take half rack space can be stored on middle or top racks where available.	50% of annual fee
Club Keys: Members who store their boats at the club can apply for a key to the club, a one time fee of \$20.00 plus \$60.00 deposit which is refunded when key is returned.	\$20.00 plus \$60.00 deposit

- Boats left on racks and not sailed are liable for removal from their racks, as detailed in the club bylaws. Boats are stored on the premises entirely at the owner's risk. The club does not carry insurance for member's boats.
